



INSTALLATION


Do not damage the body paint finish.

1. Using an awl, pierce through the seals in the holes on the left side bed lining.




2. Install the left latch to the left side bed lining with three hex bolts.

3. Remove the left front lower tie-down hook (two T-50 torx bolts).




4. Reinstall the left front lower tie-down hook and the left bracket with two T-50 torx bolts (reused).




LEFT FRONT LOWER TIE-DOWN HOOK

5. Repeat steps 1 through 4 on the right side of the vehicle.

6. On the left side of the tailgate, position the template to the tailgate as shown.




- 7. Using a center punch, mark the tailgate at the hole on the template. Remove the template.
- 8. Using a felt-tip pen, mark the right side of the tailgate at the center of the triangular plain surface as shown.




9. Using a center punch, mark the tailgate at the mark made in step 8.

10. While wearing eye protection, drill a 3 mm hole at the mark on the left side of the tailgate. Widen the hole with a 8 mm drill bit. To prevent damage to the inner vehicle parts, wrap a tape around the drill bit tip to the root in the measurement as shown. Remove any burrs.




11. Secure one well nut into the hole made in step 10.




- 12. Secure one snap-screw and one washer to the well nut.
- 13. Repeat steps 10 through 12 on the right side of the tailgate.

14. Insert three center tubes to the left tube.




15. Install the upright bar to the left tube. Make sure to install the upright bar in the correct orientation.




16. Repeat step 15 for the right tube.

17. Align the non-threaded wedge with the threaded wedge at three joints between the left and center tubes, then secure the wedges with one T-20 torx screw each.




18. Insert three center tubes to the right tube (with label).




19. Adjust three center tubes so that the distance between the outer projections on the ends of the right tube (with label) and left tube is 1,270 mm (50.00 in.).

20. Open the tailgate.




- 21. Insert two pivots on the bed extender to the latches.
- 22. Carefully pull down the bed extender onto the tailgate.




23. Secure two straps on the bed extender to two snaps on the tailgate.

24. Align the center tubes so that there is a consistent gap between the bed extender and the side bed lining.



25. Align the non-threaded wedge with the threaded wedge at three joints between the right and center tubes, then secure the wedges with one T-20 torx screw each.



26. Install the bed extender as described in the Accessory User's Information Manual provided.
