


Front template		NOTE:	
Rear template		 Do not damage the body paint finish. This body side molding kit should be installed only if th ambient air temperature is above 15°C (60°F). Heat th body side molding and the bonding surface with a ha dryer set on LOW if the ambient air temperature is below 15°C (60°F). 	
		• To allow the adhesive to cure, do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours. Please advise the customers.	
		 These installation instructions show the left side moldings being installed. The same procedure applies to installing the right side moldings. 	

1. Using an alcohol swab, clean the area where the left front body side molding will attach.




2. Insert the tab on the front template around the rear edge of the left front door.




3. Secure the front template to the left front door panel with pieces of masking tape as shown.


4. Peel back the ends of the adhesive backings shown and temporarily attach them to the outer surface of the left front body side molding with pieces of masking tape.




- 5. Remove the remaining adhesive backing.
- 6. Align the left front body side molding and attach it to the left front door as shown.




7. While applying light pressure against the left front body side molding, carefully remove the adhesive backings.




- 8. Using the palm of your hand, firmly press the body side molding against the left front door.
- 9. Remove the front template.
- 10. Using a rubber roller, apply pressure against the body side molding and roll from one end to the other.



11. Using an alcohol swab, clean the area where the left rear body side molding will attach.




12. Insert the tab on the rear template around the front edge of the left rear door.




13. Secure the rear template to the left rear door panel with pieces of masking tape as shown.


14. Peel back the ends of the adhesive backings shown and temporarily attach them to the outer surface of the left rear body side molding with pieces of masking tape.




- 15. Remove the remaining adhesive backings.
- 16. Align the left rear body side molding and attach it to the left rear door as shown.



17. While applying light pressure against the left rear body side molding, carefully remove the adhesive backings.



- 18. Using the palm of your hand, firmly press the body side molding against the left rear door.
- 19. Remove the rear template.
- 20. Using a rubber roller, apply pressure against the body side molding and roll from one end to the other.



21. Repeat steps 1 through 20 on the right side of the vehicle.
